



### Who We Are

Intown Collaborative Ministries is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to serving the most vulnerable people in our community. Our mission is to prevent and reverse homelessness and hunger in Intown Atlanta through caring relationships and transformed lives.

### What We Do

Intown serves over 1200 low-income families and homeless neighbors each year by:

- Providing 62,000 meals to 1100 families at our Food Pantry.
- Helping 51 homeless neighbors in 2017 move permanently from the streets into stable housing.
- Sending 5300 food-filled backpacks home with 300 low-income kids who lack food on weekends.
- Enrolling 62 low-income seniors in our monthly Food Co-ops to provide access to healthy food.

### Organizational Information

Intown was founded in 2010 and has a full-time executive director, four full-time and two part-time program staff, and over 300 community volunteers. Our Board of Directors is made up of 16 leaders from the local faith, legal, and business communities. Intown distributes over \$500,000 worth of services annually with support from local congregations and neighbors like you.
